

Living Hope Kids FAQs

1. What is Living Hope Kids?
 - Kids Work is Living Hope's child care program. Here children are nurtured and cared for with their peers while parents attend service.
2. Who can attend Living Hope Kids?
 - Children ages six months (or crawling) up to 6 years are welcome to attend Kids Work. Children older than 6 are free to take a busy bag, which includes a snack and activity, into the service.
3. What will my child be doing at Living Hope Kids?
 - Children will be divided into 2 age groups at Kids Work. Younger children (ages 0-3) will take part in music, play time, and stories. Older Children (ages 4-6) will sing 2-3 worship songs, take part in a bible centered lesson, and have a small snack.
4. How do I know my child will be safe?
 - All volunteers on the Kids Work team have taken and passed a background check. Volunteers work in teams of at least 2 people to ensure your child is safe. Parents are welcome to come check on your child at any time during the service.
5. How do I sign my child in?
 - Please fill out your child's information on the sign in sheet at the Kids Work table in front of Theater 4. Once you have signed in, you and your child will receive matching wristbands. You will need to show your wristband when checking your child out from Kids Work.
